The Court President introduced himself and the Court Members; there were no objections to the composition of the Court.

The competitor, Jonathan Thomas, felt the penalty imposed by the Stewards was too harsh as the technical infringement gave him no advantage and as per the 2014 Karting Regulations 11.ii, if no advantage is gained this would allow for an exception to the rule of being excluded for a technical infringement.

After having heard the evidence presented by all parties, the court finds as follows:

The Court finds in favour of the appellant and the penalty imposed by the Stewards is hereby set aside. The Court hereby directs that Jonathan Thomas (competitor 84) be re-instated into the results for race 2 and 3. The Regional Championship points are to be amended as per the revised results and the competitor is to be awarded any awards due to him.

The Court reminded the competitor of GCR 172 (x) that reads as follows:

Abuse of officials by competitors and/or their family members and/or members of their pit crew. Such breach of the rules may result in the competitors concerned, if found guilty following a hearing, being suspended for a period of up to six months or for up to six events (which is more appropriate), for a first offence.

The appeal fee, less 25% for a fine for the infringement and administrative costs, is to be returned to the appellant.

All parties are reminded of their rights to appeal to the MSA National Court of Appeal.
