INTRODUCTION

The court members and attendees were all introduced and no objections were lodged against the composition of the court.

THE HEARING

On the 21st January 2019, Motorsport South Africa (MSA) enrolled Court of Enquiry 1216 ("the Enquiry") to investigate all aspects of the technical inspection of competitor Andrew Horne's Formula Ford race car on the 29th November 2018 and the resultant outcome of the inspection.

This is the written judgement of Court of Enquiry 1216, the hearing took place on 5th February 2019 between approximately 18:30 and 19:30.

FINDINGS

Having heard all the parties present the court finds as follows:

- The court could find no compelling reasons to overturn the decision of the Clerk of the Course in excluding Mr Horne from the results of the race meeting held at Zwartkops on 3rd November 2018.
 It is further noted that Mr Horne could have:
 - At the time of the strip refused to sign the outcome and could have requested that the engine remained sealed and moved to another venue for re-measurement;
 - Submitted a protest at the time that the penalty was announced; and
 - Submitted a protest at the time when the revised points were published.

- 2. MSA is directed to re publish the 2018 Championship points. Mr Horne is directed to return his 2018 Northern Regions Championship Trophy to MSA.
- 3. The Formula Ford Association should:
 - Clearly document the process to be followed when the compression ratios are to be measured;
 - Ensure that all equipment used is in a good condition and that, where necessary, a second set of measuring devices is available for use in the event of a dispute; and
 - Ensure that all inspections are carried out in a neutral venue.
- 4. Administrative costs of R1000.00 are levied against Mr Horne.

All parties are advised of their rights in terms of GCR 212 B.
