#### INTRODUCTION

The court members and attendees were all introduced and no objections were lodged against the composition of the court.

#### THE HEARING

On 6<sup>th</sup> February 2017 Motorsport South Africa ("MSA") enrolled Court of Enquiry 1187 ("the Enquiry") to investigate whether Mr. Steve Levin had breached GCR 172 iv.

This is the written judgment of Court of Enquiry 1187. The enquiry took place on 6<sup>th</sup> February 2017 between approximately 19h00 and 19h30.

#### EVIDENCE RECEIVED

The court is somewhat dissatisfied with the lack of communication to MSA by Mr. Levin, and the failure to appear and in so doing treating this court in contempt.

Despite the court further attempting to make contact with Mr. Levin as late as 19:00 on the eve in question. The court having heard (unfortunately) only one side of the story are left with the following conclusion:

Notwithstanding the fact that Mr. Levin failed to make use of protest and appeal procedures to him at various race meetings as well as choosing to launch a verbal attack on a club member.

This court is of the opinion that the club should be dealing with its own members in such situations.

Mr. Levin is levied with R1500 court costs.
