
The Court President introduced himself and the Court Members. There were no objections to the composition of the Court.

Findings:

The Court therefore finds that Mr. Di Bella is in contravention of GCR 172 vi and in terms of GCR $^{\circ}$ S115 & 116

Mr. Di Bella's son, Turidu Di Bella is hereby given a three race ban. This includes National, Regional and Club events.

The Court finds that the actions of Mr. Di Bella is viewed in a very dim light, and he is hereby requested to reacquaint himself with the GCR handbook.
