REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS

ANY proposed / desired changes to these Championship Regulations must be submitted to the Controllers for approval. The Controllers reserve the right to introduce new Regulations and / or amend existing Regulations with the approval of Motorsport South Africa (MSA).

Amendments and updates to the rules will be recorded in the Amendment Record, detailing the updated version, date of approval of the amendment and a short summary of the amendment. The new version of the rules will be published by MSA at least seven (7) days prior to the next event being held unless a shorter notice period is approved by MSA.

All race meetings shall be held under the 2024 MSA General Competition Rules (GCR's), Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Club Regulations, the event Supplementary Regulations (SR's) and any applicable Circulars of MSA for Enduro. In the event that the Club Rules are silent, the National Rules shall, at all times prevail.

1. <u>CONTROLLERS</u>

CSMX club Committee.

2. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS

- 2.1 All competitors must hold a valid MSA competition licence for Cross Country Mcycles & Quads / Enduro
- 2.2 Only PAID UP CSMX club members will score points in this championship.
- 2.3 Non CSMX members and leisure licence holders will be removed from results when scoring club classes.

3. AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The CSMX Club Committee at its sole discretion shall declare the winners of the 2024 Club Championship in the following classes. The Committee is entitled to withhold such declaration, should circumstances warrant such action:

- E1
- E2
- Senior
- Master
- Silver
- Highschool
- Ladies
- Social
- Ladies Intro

4. <u>CLASSES</u>

4.1 E1

Motorcycles up to 200cc 2-stroke and 250 4-stroke Open to riders from the year of their 16th birthday and older 3HRS FOLLOW THE Gold Loop

4.2 E2

Motorcycles 2-stroke over 201cc and 4-stroke over 251cc Open to riders from the year of their 18th birthday and older 3HRS FOLLOW THE Gold Loop

4.3 Senior

Unrestricted capacity From the year of their 36th birthday 3HRS FOLLOW THE Gold Loop 4.4 Masters

Unrestricted capacity From the year of their 46th birthday 2HRS FOLLOW THE Gold Loop

4.5 Silver

Restricted capacity as per E1 and E2 From the year of their 16th birthday (open to riders who have not finished in the top ten overall for any preceding year or at discretion of the controllers). *3HRS FOLLOW THE Silver Loop*

4.6 Highschool

Maximum capacity motorcycle of 200cc 2-stroke Year of their 13th birthday to year of 18th birthday 3 HRS FOLLOW THE Silver Loop (NB AGE CHANGE: Starting in 2025 - From the year of the competitor's 13th-birthday, to the 31^{st of} December of the year in which their 17th birthday occurs)

4.7 Ladies

Restricted capacity as per High School, E1 and E2 From year of 13TH birthday All ladies may enter one of the above classes, and then automatically score in the Ladies. Ladies riding the Gold loop will always finish in ahead of Ladies doing the Silver Loop

4.8 Social

Restricted capacity as per E1 and E2 From year of 15th birthday 2HRS *FOLLOW THE Silver Loop*

4.9 Ladies Into Restricted capacity as per Pro 85, High School, E1 and E2 From year of 10TH birthday 90mins FOLLOW the Junior Loop

4.10 Only 1 club class may be entered

For overall position on the Gold loop, riders will be scored on most laps first and then best times, regardless of whether they are riding in the 3 or 2 hour class (2 hour competitors must stop once given the chequered flag).

8. ASSISTANCE RENDERED

When a competitor has, with the approval of the organisers, assisted with the organisation/planning of the event, the penalty of exclusion will not apply. A record of the names of the competitors who have "officially" assisted will be kept by the club
