REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS

ANY proposed / desired changes to these Championship Regulations must be submitted to the Controllers for approval. The Controllers reserve the right to introduce new Regulations and / or amend existing Regulations with the approval of Motorsport South Africa (MSA).

Amendments and updates to the rules will be recorded in the Amendment Record, detailing the updated version, date of approval of the amendment and a short summary of the amendment. The new version of the rules will be published by MSA at least seven (7) days prior to the next event being held unless a shorter notice period is approved by MSA.

All race meetings shall be held under the 2024 MSA General Competition Rules (GCR's), Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Club Regulations, the event Supplementary Regulations (SR's) and any applicable Circulars of MSA for Enduro.

1. CONTROLLERS

CSMX Club Committee.

2. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS

- 2.1 All competitors must hold a valid MSA competition licence for Cross Country Mcycles & Quads / Enduro.
- 2.2 ONLY **PAID UP** CSMX club members will score points in this championship.
- 2.3 Non CSMX members and leisure licence holders will be removed from results when scoring club classes.

3. AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The CSMX Club Committee at its sole discretion shall declare the winners of the 2024 JUNIOR Club Championship in the following classes. The Committee is entitled to withhold such declaration, should circumstances warrant such action:

- Junior 65cc motorcycles
- Junior 85cc motorcycles
- Pro 85cc motorcycles

4. CLASSES

4.1 Junior 65cc motorcycles

Open to competitors from the year of their 7th birthday, to 31st December of the year in which their 12th birthday occurs.

The maximum permissible capacity is 65cc 2 stroke or **85cc auto or 110cc 4 stroke**

Maximum wheel size 12" rear 14" front.

Chassis, suspension and engine modifications unrestricted. – **90min FOLLOW the Junior loop**

4.2 Junior 85cc motorcycles

Open to competitors from the year of their 7th birthday, to 31st December of the year in which their 12th birthday occurs.

The maximum permissible capacity is 85cc 2-stroke cooled or 150cc 4-stroke.

Minimum wheel size 12" rear 14" front. Maximum wheel size 16" rear and 19" front

Chassis, suspension and engine modifications unrestricted – **90min FOLLOW the Junior loop**

4.3 Pro 85cc motorcycles

Open to competitors from the year of their 10th birthday, to 31st December of the year in which their 15th birthday occurs.

The maximum permissible capacity is 85cc 2-stroke cooled or 150cc 4-stroke.

Minimum wheel size 14" rear and 17" front. Maximum wheel size 16" rear and 19" front.

Class, suspension and engine modifications unrestricted – **2 HRS FOLLOW the Silver loop.**

Clipper cards are required.

4.4 85cc Intro Class

Open to new competitors from the year of their 10th birthday, to 31st December of the year in which their 15th birthday occurs.

The maximum permissible capacity is 85cc 2-stroke cooled or 150cc 4-stroke.

Minimum wheel size 14" rear and 17" front. Maximum wheel size 16" rear and 19" front.

Class, suspension and engine modifications unrestricted – **90min FOLLOW the Junior loop.**

This is a **non-championship class** and requires a minimum of a Social Motorcycle Cross Country / Enduro / Quad licence.

4.3 Competitors may *not compete in more than one Club Class*

7. CLASSES WINNERS AWARDS

7.1 Minimum of 3 competitors per class to announce class winners.

7.2 If less than 3 on average are received, we will not award a champion.

8. ASSISTANCE RENDERED

When a competitor has, with the approval of the organisers, assisted with the organisation/planning of the event, the penalty of exclusion will not apply. A record of the names of the competitors who have “officially” assisted will be kept by the club

9. RACE DURATION

Race duration will be:

- Junior 65cc & 85cc motorcycles - Approx 5 to 15km of route with a 90min max race period
- Senior 85cc motorcycles - Approx 10 to 20km of route with a 2HR max race period

10. PENALTIES

Refer ART 38 of the 2024 MSA National Enduro/Extreme SSR's.

11. OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE

Although it is recommended that all competitors be capable of handling the motorcycle without assistance, it is noted that due to the difficulty of the terrain crossed, and ridden, and in the interest of growing our future riders, assistance by signed on officials & marshals is allowed, provided the rider is unable to get through an obstacle, or is trapped. There will be no chaperoning allowed
