## REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS

ANY proposed / desired changes to these Championship Regulations must be submitted to the Controllers for approval. The Controllers reserve the right to introduce new Regulations and / or amend existing Regulations with the approval of Motorsport South Africa (MSA).

Amendments and updates to the rules will be recorded in the Amendment Record, detailing the updated version, date of approval of the amendment and a short summary of the amendment. The new version of the rules will be published by MSA at least seven (7) days prior to the next event being held unless a shorter notice period is approved by MSA.

All race meetings shall be held under the 2026 MSA General Competition Rules (GCRs), Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSRs) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Club Regulations, the event Supplementary Regulations (SRs) and any applicable Circulars of MSA for Enduro. In the event that the Club Rules are silent, the National Rules shall, at all times prevail.

**1. CONTROLLERS**

CSMX Enduro Club Committee.

**2. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS**

- 2.1 All competitors must hold a valid MSA competition licence for Cross Country Mcycles & Quads / Enduro with the correct licence status or higher for the class entered
- 2.2 Only **PAID UP** CSMX club members will score points in this Championship.
- 2.3 Non CSMX members and ~~leisure~~ **social** licence holders will be removed from results when scoring club classes.

**3. AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP**

The CSMX Club Committee at its sole discretion shall declare the winners of the **2026** Club Championship in the following classes. The Committee is entitled to withhold such declaration, should circumstances warrant such action:

- Highschool
- Ladies
- Pro 85
- 85cc Junior
- 65cc
- Ladies Intro

- 4.2 Only one (1) club class may be entered, with the exception of our Ladies riders, who are allowed to compete in both the Ladies club class and another Club/Regional class.
- 4.3 For overall position on the Gold loop, riders will be scored on most laps first and then best times, regardless of whether they are riding in the three (3) or two (2) hour class (two (2) hour competitors must stop once given the chequered flag).

## 7. START ORDER

~~The starting order is determined by overall position. The club runs an overall across all classes, including the Gold loop (E1, E2, Senior, and Master), Highschool, Silver, Pro 85, Social, and the Junior loop (85cc Jnr, 65cc and Ladies Intro) to establish the start order. NEW riders in each class will be positioned at the back, based on their bike number. However, organisers may move riders forward at their discretion.~~

The starting order for the first event of the season will be based on the previous year's CSMX Overall Championship points, Gold overall will start first, followed by the overall Championship points of the remaining classes. Riders moving into a new class will not carry a seeded ranking with them to this class, and will be positioned at the back of their class, based on their race number. From the second event onward, the starting order will be determined by the current Overall Gold points (E1/E2/E3 Seniors/E3 Masters), Highschool, Silver, Pro 85, Social, Junior overall (65cc, 85cc Jnr & Ladies Intro) each seeded according to their class Championship points. At the discretion of the Clerk of the Course, and with agreement from the event organisers, a non-seeded competitor with significant prior experience may be moved forward in the starting order.

## 8. CLASSES WINNERS AWARDS

8.1 Minimum of (3) three competitors per class to announce class winners.

8.2 If less than (3) three on average over the CSMX racing season are received, we will not award a Champion.

## 9. SCRUTINEERING

Competitors must complete a self-declaration scrutineering form prior to the event, which must be submitted to the Secretary of the Meeting. Random scrutineering may be carried out before, during and after the event, and at least 10% of entries will be checked by the scrutineer/s. This requirement supplements, and does not replace, the obligations of licenced officials under GCR 166 and GCR 245 - 247.

A penalty of exclusion will be applied for any false declaration on the self-declaration scrutineering form. Deviances will be noted in a Scrutineering Logbook held by the Organisers / Promoter. Should a competitor be selected for scrutineering checks and fail to appear for scrutineering, a fine of R250 may be imposed, payable to MSA.

All competitor's race numbers must comply with the National Regulations, refer to ART 11 of the 2026 MSA National Enduro & Hard Enduro Standing Supplementary Regulations. In instances where numbers do not comply, a fine of R250 may be imposed.

If the number is not rectified by the next event, the club reserves the right to refuse your entry as per GCR 99.

## 10. ASSISTANCE RENDERED

When a competitor has, with the approval of the organisers, assisted with the organisation/planning of the event, the penalty of exclusion will not apply. A record of the names of the competitors who have "officially" assisted will be kept by the club

## 11. PENALTIES

Refer ART 15 of the 2026 MSA National Standing Supplementary Regulations for Enduro and Hard Enduro.

## **12. OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE**

Although it is recommended that all JUNIOR Loop competitors 65ccc, 85cc JNR and Ladies Intro be capable of handling the motorcycle without assistance, it is noted that due to the difficulty of the terrain crossed, and ridden, and in the interest of growing our future riders, assistance by signed on officials & marshals is allowed for 65cc, 85cc JNR & Ladies Intro only, provided the rider is unable to get through an obstacle, or is trapped. There will be no chaperoning allowed.
