3. INJURY REGISTER

- Where a competitor has appeared on the injury register, it is that competitor's responsibility to ensure that they have submitted a medical certificate indicating that they are fit to compete in motorsport no later than 5 (five) working days before the start of the event. This certificate is to be reviewed and processed by MSA Head Office.

- It is the responsibility of the competitor to check the Injury Register and ensure that MSA receives their letter timeously.

- Please Note: Competing while appearing on the injury register will result in potential claims being repudiated by the MSA Group Accident Policy. Refer to Appendix L.

Finish time Three official clocks will be used - one for each race duration (3hour, 2hour, and 90mins). Each clock starts when the first rider in that category sets off. Once the clock reaches its full duration, all riders in that category will receive the checkered flag, regardless of their individual start time

Clipper Cards Riders remain responsible for ensuring their clipper cards are correctly and clearly stamped at each clipper point before leaving the area. Non-stamped cards will result in a penalty as per ART 15 of the 2026 MSA SA National Enduro & Hard Enduro SSR's. Rider statements or witness confirmation will not be accepted as proof.
